ACADEMIC ARENA...THE APPROACH...THE ACHIEVEMENTS

✱ The school has Classes from **Balvatika-I** to **XII**. Each class is housed in airy, spacious, well-ventilated and well-lit rooms.

✱ A holistic approach is adopted to educate students, which lays emphasis on understanding and application of the knowledge acquired.

✱ Activity-oriented **Experiential Learning** methods are implemented to enhance the interest of the **tiny tots** in the junior section and the process of '**Learning by Doing**' is implemented in the middle and senior sections.



✱ Over the years, the school has been producing **100% pass result** at the **AISSE** (Class X) & **AISSCE** (Class XII) with most of the students securing distinction marks in various subjects. Students of the school have also been qualifying competitive examinations like **VVM, JEE, NEET, CEE, CUET, NSE** etc.

✱ To encourage E-learning in the school, lessons are imparted through **SMART CLASS, VIRTUAL CLASSROOM, HYBRID MODE**, etc.

♣ THE SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION

❖ As per existing policy of CBSE the performance of the students is assessed by means of Periodic / Unit Tests/Formative Assessment, Half-Yearly and Annual Examination/ Summative Assessment as per the Guidelines of CBSE.

❖ Co- Scholastic Areas as specified by the CBSE are also assessed.

❖ Subject to revision as per changes in the CBSE guidelines.

♣ SALIENT FEATURES:

- ❖ Highly professional and dedicated faculty and administrative staff.
- ❖ In-House workshops conducted by the faculty members to share innovative methods of teaching.
- ❖ Guest Faculty invited from time-to-time to conduct classes/workshops for students as well as teachers.
- ❖ The students of the school are divided into four Houses namely **Dihing, Dikhow, Dhansiri and Luit** named after the four **tributaries of the mighty Brahmaputra**. Various **Inter-House** literary, cultural and sports activities are held in which the students showcase their talents, powered with their innovative skills.
- ❖ Various **Intra-class/Inter-House** competitions are conducted every Friday/Saturday.
- ❖ Regular classes are conducted in **Games & Sports, Yoga, Music (Vocal & Instrumental), Dance and Art & Craft**.
- ❖ The school also has the **NCC** in which interested students can enrolled from Class VIII.
- ❖ **Field trips / Educational Tour and Excursions** conducted for students.
- ❖ **Special Assemblies** held to observe/commemorate/celebrate special days/festivals throughout the Academic Year.



STATE-OF-THE-ART INFRASTRUCTURE...

- ❖ Separate wings for **junior, middle and senior** sections.
- ❖ **Audio-Visual-cum-Activity Room**.
- ❖ **Botanical Garden** housing a large number of fruit-bearing trees, medicinal plants, plants of various spices and shade-providing trees.
- ❖ A **Multi-Purpose Hall/Auditorium** with **Centralised AC** having a seat capacity of over **1500 people**.
- ❖ **Digital Library** as a Resource Portal for all.
- ❖ Well-equipped **Computer, Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Geography and Mathematics** Laboratories with all basic facilities.
- ❖ Resource Centre with facilities of Internet, Projector etc.
- ❖ Air-conditioned Conference Hall.
- ❖ A **Duplex Library** with separate **Reference and Reading sections**, with a stock of over **10,000 titles** on various subjects.

ACADEMIC SESSION AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE :

- ❖ **Academic Session** begins in the month of **April** each year.
- ❖ There is no assessment for students seeking admission in Class Nursery and Preparatory.
- ❖ Students seeking admission in Classes **I-X** are assessed in **English, Mathematics, Science and Hindi**.
- ❖ Assessment for **XI & XII** will be based on the Subject Combination opted.

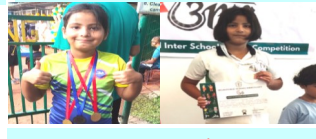
