Registration for Admission to Class Balvatika-I to Class IX for the Academic Session **2026-27** will be open from **15.12.2025 (Monday)** to **17.01.2026 (Saturday)**.


- Parents are required to register their wards through the online registration link available in the school's Website: [www.dpsnazira.net](http://www.dpsnazira.net) free of cost.
- Parents may obtain Registration Form from the school office during office hours (from **08.30 a.m. to 02.30 p.m.**) on all working days on payment of Registration Fee of **Rs. 500/-** through cash /online fund transfer.
- Registration will begin from **15.12.2025 (Monday)** and close on **17.01.2026 (Saturday)**.
- However, request for registration from ONGC wards whose parents will be transferred to ONGC-Assam Asset, during the **Session 2026-27**, will be in force.
- Age criteria will be followed in accordance with the NEP 2020 and guidelines of Govt. of Assam for the entry levels (Balvatika –I to Class I) as mentioned in the notification and the management reserves the right to cancel the Registration Form in case of non-fulfillment of Age Criteria.
- Date of Written Test/Assessment/Interaction will be given at the time of registration or displayed on the school notice board/School Website. The same may be altered and will be intimated through the school's website.

- Certificate from the employer (ONGC/CISF/CRPF/Central Govt. /State Govt.), if applicable.
- A copy of **Aadhaar Card** of the child.
- A copy of **Aadhaar Card/ Unique Identity Card** in the name of any of the parents.
- A copy of **Passport** (if issued).
- A copy of **BPL Certificate** (if applicable).
- Medical Fitness Certificate** issued by Health Department/a registered Medical Practitioner.
- A copy of the **Certificate of Disability** of the child (if any).

### • ACADEMIC ARENA...THE APPROACH.....THE ACHIEVEMENTS

The school has Classes from Balvatika-I to XII. Each class is housed in airy, spacious, well-ventilated and well-lit rooms.

- A holistic approach is adopted to educate students, which lays emphasis on understanding and application of the knowledge acquired.
- Activity-oriented Experiential Learning methods are implemented to enhance the interest of the tiny tots in the junior section and the process of 'Learning by Doing' is implemented in the middle and senior sections along with STEM.
- Over the years, the school has been producing 100% pass result at the AISSE (Class X) & AISSC (Class XII) with most of the students securing distinction marks in various subjects. Students of the school have also been qualifying competitive examinations like VVM, JEE, NEET, CEE, CUET, NSE, etc.
- To encourage E-learning in the school, lessons are imparted through SMART CLASS, VIRTUAL CLASSROOM, HYBRID MODE, etc.

## • SALIENT FEATURES:

- Highly professional and dedicated faculty and administrative staff.
- In-House workshops conducted by the faculty members to share innovative methods of teaching.
- Guest Faculty invited from time-to-time to conduct classes/workshops for students as well as teachers.
- The students of the school are divided into four Houses namely Dihing, Dikhow, Dhansiri and Luit, named after the four tributaries of the mighty Brahmaputra. Various Inter-House literary, cultural and sports activities are held in which the students showcase their talents, powered with their innovative skills.
  - Various Intra-class/Inter-House competitions are conducted every Friday/Saturday.
