



REPORT ON CBSE SAFAL ASSESSMENT 2025



The CBSE SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning Levels) assessment for the academic session **2024–25** was successfully conducted at **DPS ONGC, Nazira** during the months of **November and December 2025** for **Grade 5 (Class VI – Session 2025–26)** and **Grade 8 (Class IX – Session 2025–26)** students. SAFAL, an initiative introduced by CBSE, aims to strengthen competency-based learning and evaluate students' foundational understanding across key subjects.

SAFAL is designed to assess learning outcomes, identify areas requiring academic support, and provide actionable insights to improve overall teaching–learning practices. The assessment emphasizes conceptual clarity, critical thinking, and real-life application rather than rote memorization.

Objectives of SAFAL

- Evaluate students' foundational competencies across core subjects.
- Provide meaningful feedback on individual learning gaps.
- Promote competency-based learning by assessing understanding and application.
- Enable holistic academic development by generating comprehensive performance insights.
